ADDENDUM TO THE PANEL'S DECISION DATED MAY 8, 2020

This addendum is rendered as a result of questions that were posed to seek clarification regarding 3 facts within the panel's written decision dated May 8, 2020 and amended on May 21, 2020.

1. On page 2 of the decision, it is stated that participants are required to hold a Canadian Five Pin (C5) membership card to compete in a national bowling tournament. To clarify this point, it should be noted that in order to compete in any Canadian five pin national tournaments other than YBC, MBAM, and BPAM sponsored tournaments, the participant must hold a C5 membership card that is renewable on an annual basis.
2. On page 2 of the decision, it is stated that Shane Barry was a member of the 2019 Manitoba Masters Men's Team. To clarify, Shane Barry was an alternate and not a direct member of the team. Although he attended practices with the team, he would only be named to the team if any of the other team members would not be able to compete at nationals.
3. On pages 6-7 of the decision under part c) i), it is stated that the respondent's conduct was unbecoming of a member of the MBAM and a violation of the General Rules. It would be more accurate to state that the conduct was unbecoming of an athlete under the Manitoba Five Pin Bowling Federation Discipline and Complaints Policy since the event discussed was not a MBAM event.

These clarifications do not impact the Panel's final decision and are being issued to ensure accuracy of information related to the decision.
